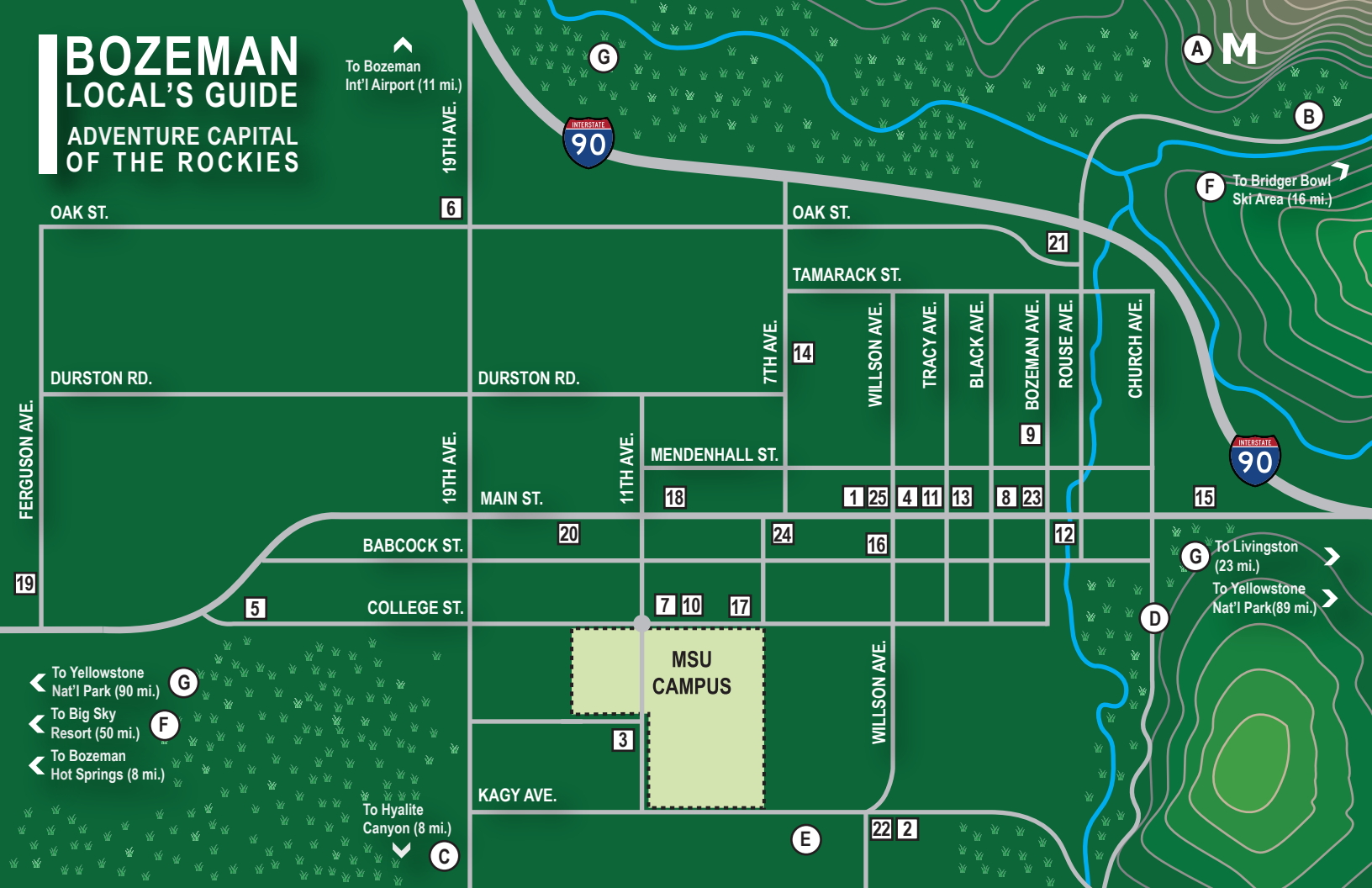

ACTIVITIES & ADVENTURES

- A** **COLLEGE "M" TRAIL HIKE**
Grab a birds-eye view of the Gallatin Valley from the top of our "M" on Mount Baldy! Take the easier route for a leisurely hike, or the more intense route for a real workout.
- B** **DRINKING HORSE TRAIL HIKE**
Looking to avoid the traffic on the "M" trail? Try Drinking Horse! Follow a meandering trail to the summit on the hill for some fantastic views of Bozeman.
- C** **HYALITE CANYON**
Check out Bozeman's backyard! Home to dozens of day hikes, a beautiful reservoir, and soaring peaks, this canyon 20 minutes south of town offers adventure in every season.
- D** **PEET'S HILL**
A local favorite, Peet's Hill and Lindley Park offer easy access to the outdoors right on downtown's doorstep. Check out the Main Street to the Mountains trail while you're there.
- E** **MUSEUM OF THE ROCKIES**
Visit the largest collection of dinosaur remains in the United States! Catch a show at the planetarium or view one of the dozens of major exhibits that visit Bozeman annually.
- F** **HIT THE SLOPES**
Bozeman is lucky enough to be located within an hour's drive of two wonderful ski hills: Bridger Bowl and Big Sky Resort! Check with our staff about discounted lift tickets.
