

COMPLIMENTARY TICKETS

As a Montana State University student-athlete, you are entitled to four (4) complimentary admissions, for use by your family and friends, to each home contest in the sport in which you participate. NCAA regulations forbid any player from having an actual game ticket in his/her possession at any time. As a result, you are required by the NCAA to fill out a request for tickets.

For participants in good standing, in sports other than football, tickets may be requested through Belinda Pence (in the Athletics Administrative offices). Requests can be made starting Monday of game week with a deadline of 5:00 PM the day before the game.

For football student-athletes in good standing, requests for tickets to home contests may be made through a pass list request form which will be available in the weight room beginning on the Monday of game week. All requests must be submitted by 4pm, Thursday before the game. Football student-athletes may receive up to two complimentary tickets to each away-from-home contest for which the student-athlete is listed on the travel roster. Please note: travel rosters are per game and may change at any time. Requests for away-from-home complimentary tickets will follow the same procedures as requests for home contests.

NOTE: STUDENT-ATHLETES MAY GAIN ADMISSION TO ANY ATHLETICS EVENT USING THEIR ONE CARD, THE SAME METHOD USED BY THE GENERAL STUDENT BODY.

COMPLIMENTARY ADMISSIONS POLICY

Complimentary admissions shall be provided only through a pass list for individuals designated by the student-athlete. "Hard tickets" shall not be issued. The student-athlete's eligibility shall be affected by involvement in action contrary to the provisions (i.e., receipt of more than the permissible complimentary admissions or the sale or exchange of a complimentary admission for any item of value).

The individual utilizing the complimentary admission must present identification to the person supervising the use of the pass list at the admission gate. The individual then shall be provided a ticket stub or other identification of a specified reserved seat or treated as a general-admission ticket holder.

NON-PERMISSIBLE TICKET PROCEDURES

– A student-athlete may not receive payment from any source for his/her complimentary admissions and may not exchange or assign them for any item of value.

– Individuals designated by the student-athlete to receive complimentary admissions are not permitted to receive any type of payment for these admissions or to exchange or assign them for any item of value. Receipt of payment for complimentary admissions by such designated individuals is prohibited and considered an extra benefit not available to the general student body, which would render the student-athlete ineligible for participation in intercollegiate athletics.

- An institution may not provide a special arrangement to sell a student-athlete ticket(s) to an athletics event. Tickets shall be available for purchase by student-athletes according to the same purchasing procedures used for other students.
- A student-athlete may not purchase tickets for an athletics contest from the institution and then sell the tickets at a price greater than their face value.
- An institution or any representative of its athletics interest may not purchase or otherwise obtain tickets to a professional sports contest and make these tickets available to student-athletes enrolled in an NCAA member institution. Such a gift of tickets would represent an unacceptable extra benefit.
