RE: Strategic Investment Proposal Recommendations

Last October, a process was developed by the MSU Budget Council to create a list of ideas which could be used to strategically improve the university, if and when funds became available. We asked the campus community to submit proposals supporting MSU's Mission, Core Themes, and Objectives. In January of this year, the Budget Council recommended that \$1.2 million of our existing FY12 budget, which had been conservatively unallocated to campus units in case student enrollment did not meet our projections, be used to fund some of the investment proposals. The Budget Council has now reviewed each proposal, its strategic focus, its campus-wide impact, and its affect on the Board of Regents goal of 70 percent spending in Instruction, Academic Support, and Student Services.

The following page contains a list of the 31 proposals that captured the initial interest of the Budget Council and were reviewed at public hearings on Feb. 8 - 9. These proposals are listed in the order of highest (at the top) interest / priority by the Budget Council after its careful consideration, including the public hearings and a thorough discussion on Feb. 23. Also included for each proposal is its most prominent strategic focus, aligning with MSU's strategic plan which is currently being developed. It is not our intent that these proposals necessarily be funded in the order listed, but instead be funded based on your leadership and expertise of campus needs. Additionally, the Budget Council recommends further analysis of the funding required for each proposal before authorization to proceed, and in some cases, recommends significantly lower funding and/or partial implementation.

Finally, we have provided three pages containing all proposals, sorted by their most prominent strategic focus and placed in the order of highest (at the top) interest / priority by the Budget Council for each area. The yellow shading denotes the 31 proposals heard at public hearings. Brief descriptions of each proposal were also created since the proposal titles do not all accurately describe the intent of the proposal.

I would like to commend all those who submitted a proposal, as well as all the Budget Council members who reviewed and deliberated on the proposals. Everyone did a wonderful job to make this process a success. We look forward to making some improvements as we prepare to institutionalize this strategic process, which helps us be the best stewards possible of our limited resources.
