

- 3. One page written essay describing yourself, your notable achievements or special attributes, your professional goals, and aspirations in engineering and/or computer science.
- 4. **Native American/Alaskan Native applicants** must submit documentation of tribal status by providing a copy of certificate of tribal enrollment or other documentation. Documentation from more than one tribe is acceptable if a student is of mixed blood descent.
