
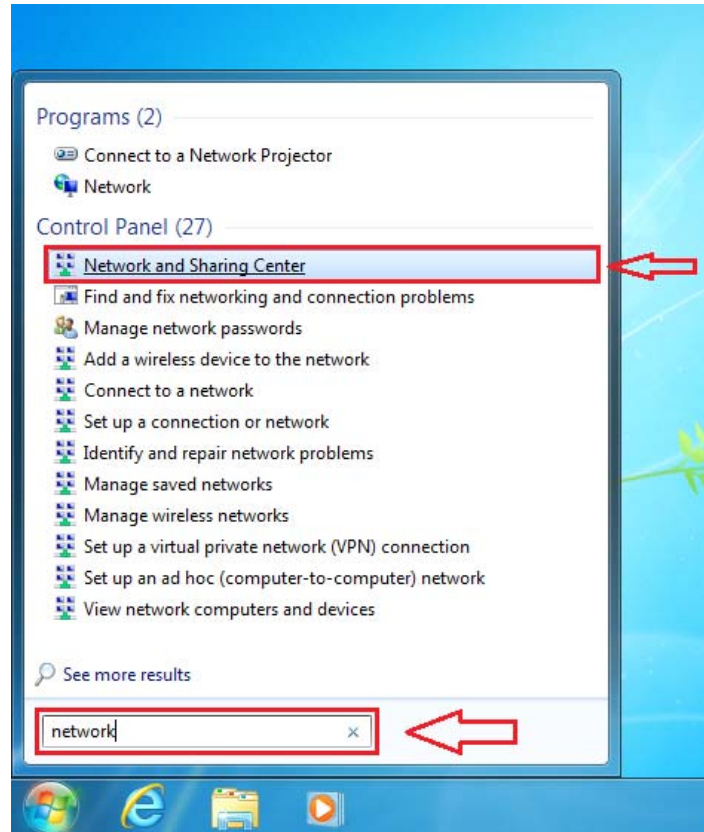
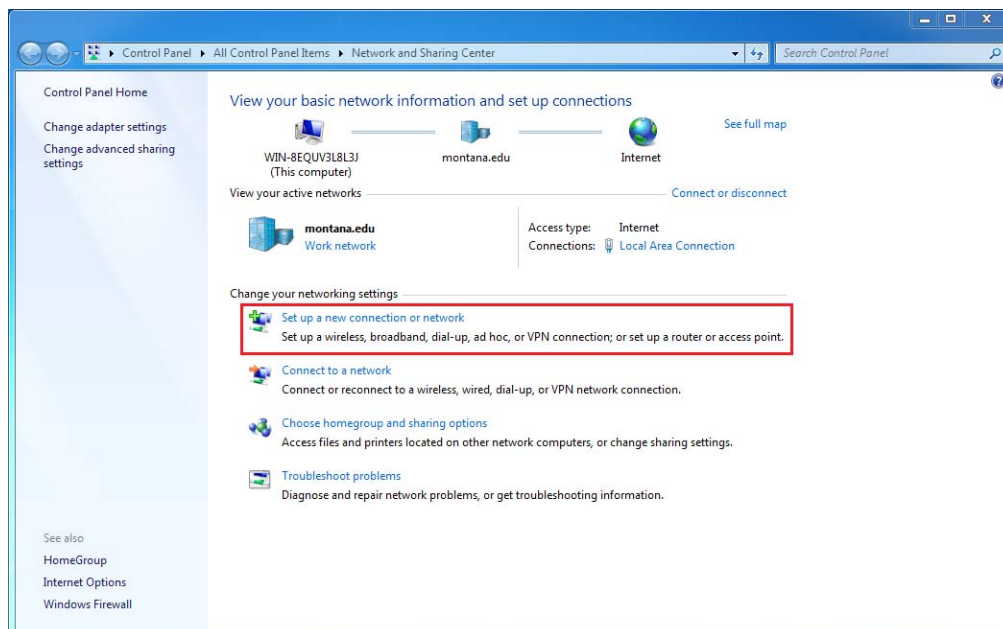


## College of Letters and Science Windows 7 VPN instructions.

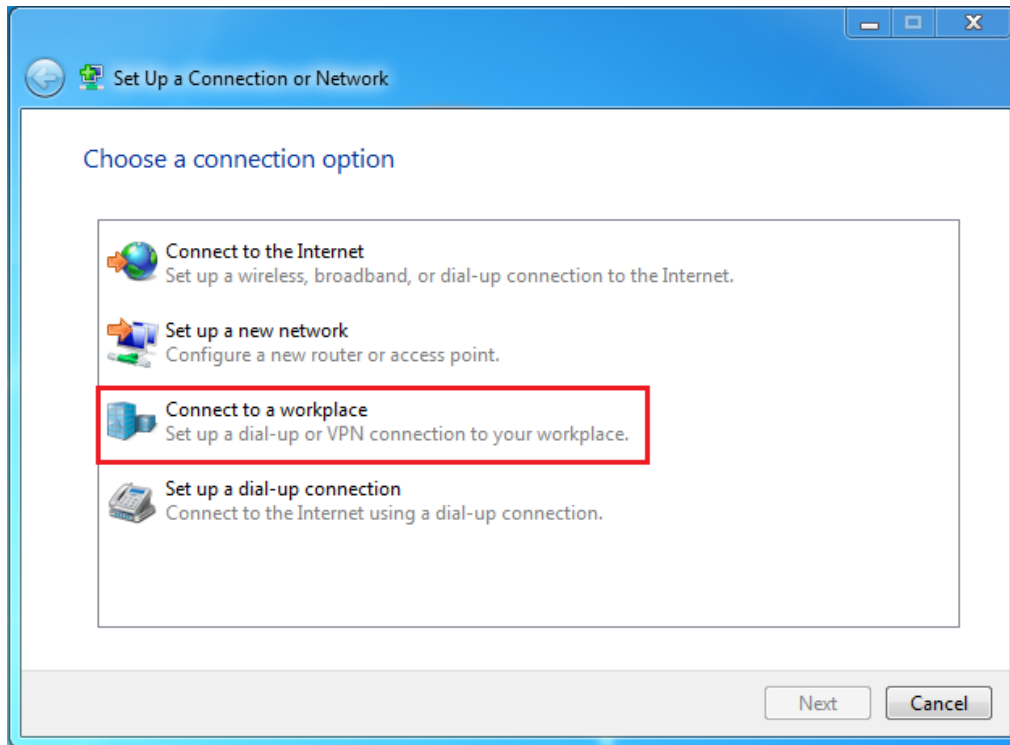
**Step 1:** Press with Windows key  on your keyboard type the word “network”. Once the search results populate, click “Network and Sharing Center” from the start menu.



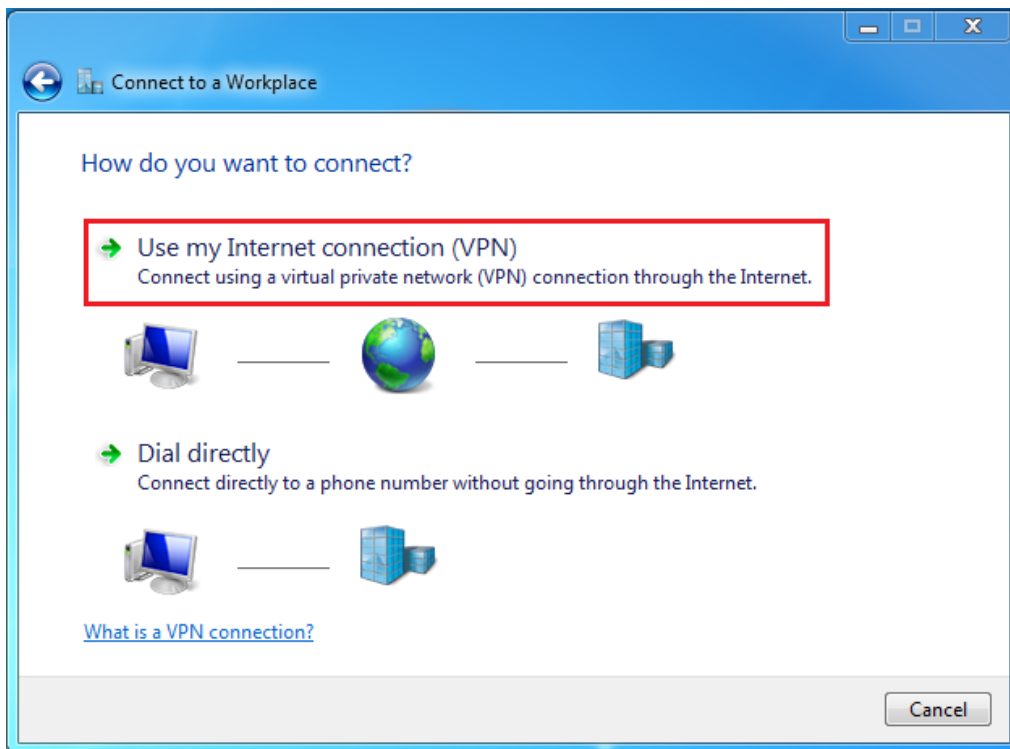
**Step 2:** Click “Set up a new connection or network”



**Step 3:** Click “Connect to a workplace”



**Step 4:** Click “Use my Internet connection (VPN)”



**Step 5:** Enter “vpn.montana.edu” in the Internet address field, “MSU VPN” in the Destination name field, and check the “Don’t connect now” box.

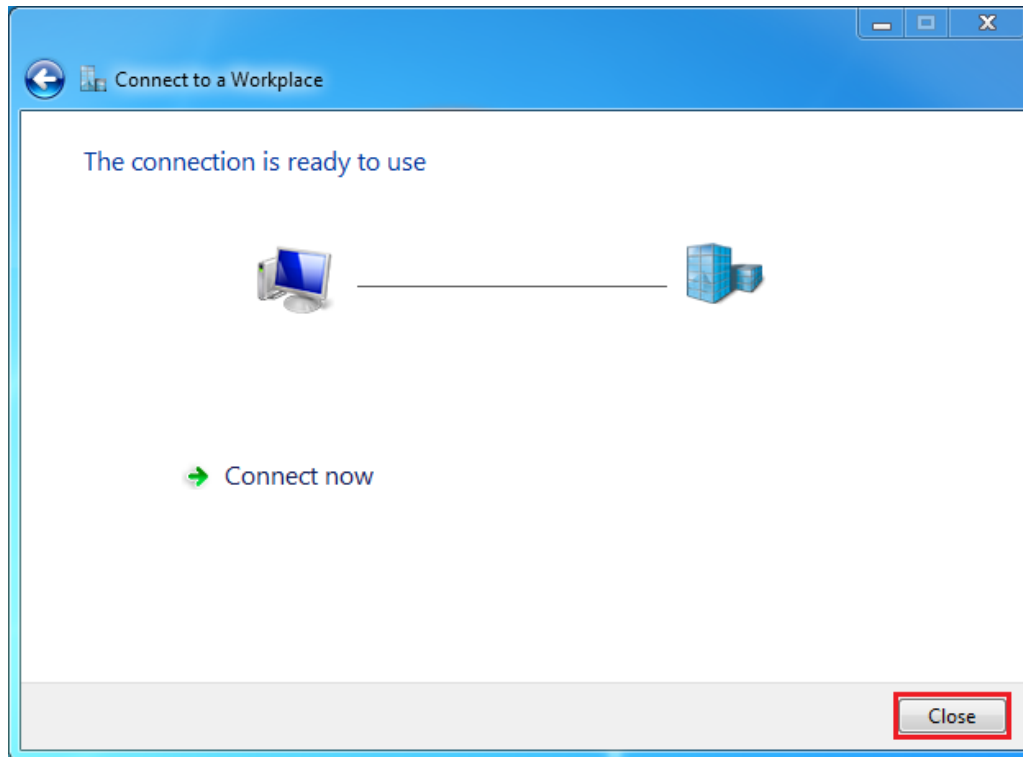

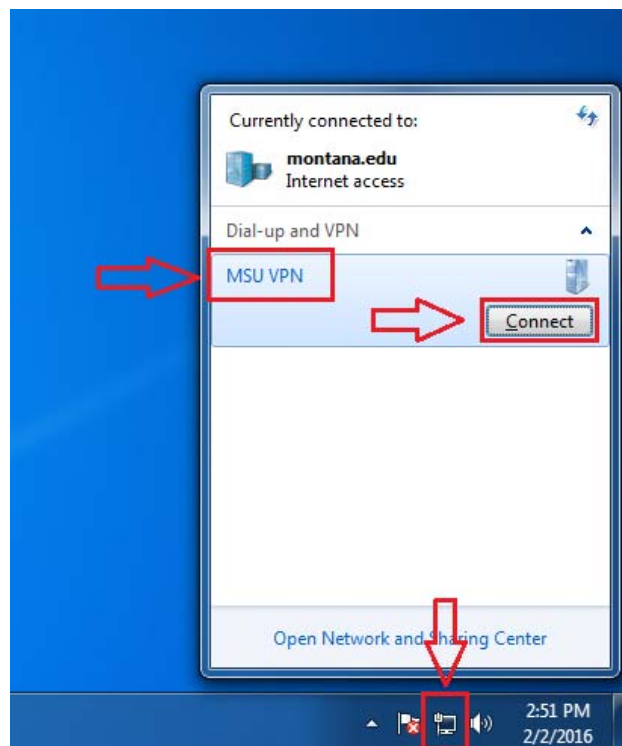

**Step 7:** Click “Close”
