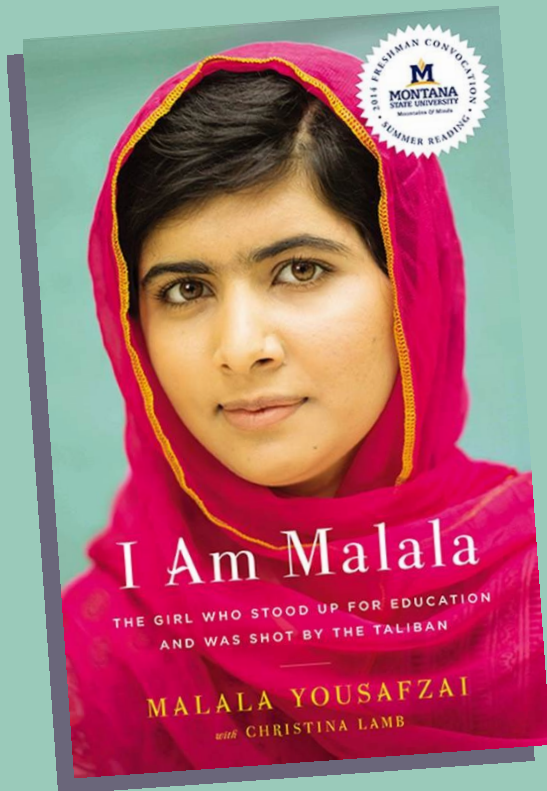


Writer's Voice Competition
