

Core Completion Checklist for CONTINUING Students

If you entered MSU before Fall 2004, you will be able to graduate with the original core, or you may convert to CORE 2.0. To help you decide, use this checklist along with the automatic conversion table at www.montana.edu/newcore.

Verbal (V) (3 credits with a C- grade or better)	
Mathematics (M) (3 credits with a C- grade or better)	
Writing (W) (3 credits with a C- grade or better)	
Fine Arts (F) (3 credits)	
Humanities (H) (6 credits)	
Social Sciences (S) (6 credits)	
Natural Science (N) (8 credits, 1 course with lab)	
Multicultural/Global (G) (6 credits)	
Note: Courses with more than one core designation (such as HG) may count towards completion of both core areas only in the Original Core.

Seminar (US) (1 course) <i>Verbal (V) 3 CR with a C- grade or better</i>	
Quantitative Reasoning (Q) (1 course) <i>Mathematics (M) 3 CR with a C- grade or better</i>	
Writing (W) (1 course) <i>Writing (W) 3 CR with a C- grade or better</i>	
Inquiry-Arts (IA) (1 course) <i>Fine Arts (F) 3 CR</i>	
Inquiry-Humanities (IH) (1 course) <i>Humanities (H) 3 CR</i>	
Inquiry-Social Sciences (IS) (1 course) <i>Social Sciences (S) 3 CR</i>	
Inquiry-Natural Science (IN) (1 course) <i>Natural Science (N) 3 CR</i>	
Diversity (D) (1 course) <i>Multicultural/Global (G) 3 CR</i>	
Research and Creative Experience (R) (3 credits) <i>2nd Humanities (H) or 2nd Social Science (S) or a total of 3 credits of 289, 290, 489 or 490</i>	
Contemporary Issues in Science (CS) (1 course) <i>2nd Natural Science (N) 3 CR</i>	

NOTE: Only original core courses taken before Fall 2004 may be converted to CORE 2.0. Double counting is NOT permitted in the conversion to CORE 2.0. Starting Fall 2004, students must receive a C- or better to fulfill CORE 2.0 course requirements.
