Course description:

Students in this class will participate in the design, creation and presentation of individual and collaborative projects which explore processes used in creative work. Students in any discipline are encouraged to seek consent of instructor for enrollment.

Working from a general, over-arching concept of collage, students will bring to the course their own set of skills, frame of reference and diverse talents to share in an actively participatory, collaborative experience to explore and further learn about the creative process, how it applies to their work and how others use it in theirs. The course will use a variety of methods to present content ranging from guest speaker lectures, films, music, writings, and hands-on projects in addition to conducting individual and collaborative research.

Students will develop both a comprehensive individual project and participate in a group project. Presentation, sharing what's been discovered, will be a big part of this course.

Students will be encouraged to apply to the undergraduate scholars program to present their work.
