1. Research Computing

- a. Dr. Gwen Jacobs has announced she will leave MSU to take a faculty post at Univ of Hawaii and Director Cyberinfrastrcture.
- b. Visioning Committee
 - i. Will have two groups
 - 1. Researcher Led Group
 - 2. Support Staff Led Group
 - ii. All committee members (researchers) are in place pending names from Engineering and Arts & Architecture.
 - iii. Will start deliberations first of March and finish by final exams
 - iv. Spend summer creating operating plan and sustainable business model
 - v. Will present final plan to committees in Sept for approval
 - vi. Will work with Provost, VPR, VPFA to identify funding mechanisms
 - vii. If approved & funded, will start national search for center director in January 2014
 - viii. Have center director on board and ready to launch center in July 2014

2. Program Management Office (montana.edu/pmo)

- a. The website is up and going listing 40+ major projects
 - i. Project intake process is up and being refined.
 - ii. IT Procurement is being run through the PMO through delegated agreement with Univ. Purchasing
- b. Two PM's have now been hired; one is already on board.
- c. The Bozeman IT Steering Committee to be chaired by Provost
 - i. Subcommittees for T&L, Research, Infrastructure, Enterprise to report up to Bozeman IT Steering Committee with projects and recommendations

3. OpenMSU

- a. Enterprise Content Management (a.k.a. Workflow and Document Imaging) in progress
- b. Dave Court from Admin & Finance is the PM for the Project working with the PMO
 - i. Due diligence phase is underway
 - ii. Solution gate targeted for March/April
 - iii. Implementation with two target departments starting in May and going through summer implementation.
 - iv. After successful pilot, we'll start a larger program around deploying to balance of campus.
