In addition to the responsibilities below, there may be the opportunity to assist in the field during a week-long photography workshop.

Responsibilities:

Wildlife Photography

- Writing engaging titles and accurate captions for wildlife photographs
- Creating short documentary and promotional videos from video clips in the archives
- Upload new images to the website as needed
- Light design work including creation of flyers and e-mail campaigns
- Able to assist with creating PowerPoint presentations

Social Media

- Write conservation photography posts for Instagram and Facebook
- Produce posts for fine art print sales and field photography workshops
- Perform keyword and hashtag analysis
- Optimize social media reach
- Monitor, post, and comment on social media

Qualifications:

- Basic knowledge of wildlife species, behavior and ecosystems
- Basic knowledge of Final Cut Pro or Adobe Premiere.
- Basic knowledge of Adobe Lightroom Classic and Photoshop.
- Basic knowledge of PowerPoint
- Basic knowledge of social media platforms

Schedule and Compensation:

- 6-16 hours per week around intern's schedule during the academic year; the opportunity for 16 or more hours per week during the summer. The office is located in Big Timber, Montana. Once intern is familiar with duties, approximately 75% of the work can be done remotely.
