We are looking for 13 CWD technicians for our Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD) Surveillance Project for the fall of 2019 (approximately October 15<sup>th</sup> to December 6<sup>th</sup>) to operate hunter check stations and collect biological samples from hunter-harvested and road-killed animals. Hunter check station locations will be in Missoula, Libby, Chester, Ekalaka, Ashland, Hysham, Malta, Glasgow, and Plentywood Montana.
