Hi, All,

We are looking for 13 CWD technicians for our Chronic Wasting Disease (CWD) Surveillance Project for the fall of 2019 (approximately October 15th to December 6th) to operate hunter check stations and collect biological samples from hunter-harvested and road-killed animals. Hunter check station locations will be in Missoula, Libby, Chester, Ekalaka, Ashland, Hysham, Malta, Glasgow, and Plentywood Montana. The CWD technicians will mainly be responsible for collecting biological samples, recording accurate field data, properly labeling and maintaining accountability of all samples, entering sample data into a database, organizing and packaging samples, and submitting them in a timely manner to the appropriate testing facility. These are short-term worker positions with an hourly pay of \$13.79.
