

ECNS and AGBU Majors & Minors

As a reminder, ECNS312, ECNS432, and AGE421 will NOT be offered for 2010-2011 academic year

AGE421 – Advanced Agricultural Marketing will **NOT** be offered during Spring 2011. The course covers an upper-division credit and is an either/or course choice with AGE445 in the AgBus major. Students graduating in Spring 2011 or Fall 2011 should plan on enrolling in AGE445 during Spring 2011.

ECNS 432R – Cost-Benefit Analysis will **NOT** be offered during Spring 2011. The course covers the R CORE designation, fulfills one of two 400-level course requirements for the ECON major, and fulfills the capstone requirement for the ECON major. If you are planning to graduate either Spring 2011 or Fall 2011, you should consider the alternatives below to meet your graduation requirements:

Alternative **R** courses for ECNS 432:

- AGE451R – Economics of Agricultural Policy Fall TTH 9:30-10:45
- ECNS 305R – Peer Leadership in Economics Spring (offered as ECNS 492 Fall 2010) **Pending CORE curriculum approval, expected Fall 2010
- ECNS 403R – Introduction to Econometrics Spring TTH 12:45-2:00 **Pending CORE curriculum approval, expected Fall 2010.

Alternative **400-level** courses for ECNS 432:

- ECNS 406 – Industrial Organization Fall TTH 11:00-12:45 (prereq. ECNS 301)
- AGE451R – Economics of Agricultural Policy Fall TTH 9:30-10:45 (prereq. ECNS 301)
- ECNS 403 – Introduction to Econometrics Spring TTH 12:45-2:00
- AGE445 – Agribusiness Management Spring MWF 2:10-3:00 (prereq. AGE435 or FIN 352)

Other course changes you should be aware of:

- ECNS 313 will now be offered only once per year. It will be offered Fall 2010 but not Spring 2011. After that, it will be offered spring semesters only
- ECNS 317 will be offered in alternate years, beginning spring 2011
- ECNS 312 will be offered in alternate years, beginning spring 2012
- AGE445 will be offered in alternate years, beginning spring 2011
- AGE421 will be offered in alternate years, beginning spring 2012
