**Health Research with Underserved Populations:** Projects include: Increasing Native American women's cervical health, counseling with rural populations, assessing family functioning in low-income African-American families with an HIV infected mother, and assessing post-partum depression in low-income women.

**Family Research:** Projects include: Assessing family influence on siblings of children with ADHD, divorce and family functioning, children and divorce, social interest and family functioning, children's coping with painful medical procedures, and the relationship between child temperament and parental response.

**Administration:** Administrative responsibilities include establishing and HDC policies and procedures, screening clients presenting for treatment, managing HDC budget, managing HDC client data base, maintaining records of student professional hours, training HDC interns and practicum students, hosting student orientation activities, and supervising work-study students.
