Requirements for Acceptance into the Teacher Education Program

1. A minimum of **2.50** cumulative GPA.
2. A total minimum **2.50** GPA in University Seminar, College Writing and Quantitative Reasoning (CORE) with no grade lower than a 'C' (a grade of 'C-' or lower is not accepted).
3. A **2.50 GPA** in the teaching major, minor, and professional area with no grade below a "C" in any of these areas.
4. A record free of, "conviction of, entry of a guilty verdict, a plea of guilty, or a plea of no contest to a criminal offense involving moral turpitude in this state or any other state or country". (Montana Annotated Code, Sec. 20-4-110)

In order to meet the requirement for question #4 (above), you need to answer the following questions:

a. Have you ever been convicted of a crime more serious than a minor traffic violation? This disclosure must be made regardless of whether the record was sealed or expunged, you served a sentence and had your civil rights restored, the sentenced was deferred or suspended, or the charge was dismissed after conviction.
