# Announcements

- Budget Adjustment (Hoo)
  - Potential \$23 million across Montana University System cut from budget over 2 years
- MSSE (Hoo)
  - o Director Dr. Peggy Taylor passed away in December 2016
  - Program is now housed under Letters & Science; there will be a search for a new director
- Task Force reports to be shared with Faculty Senate (Hoo)
  - o Contains 3 reports: Graduate Education, Research, Workload policy
  - Faculty Senate has workload policy on their spring agenda in conjunction with finishing faculty handbook

- Will task force reports be disseminated to campus? Unsure when or how.
- PhD Dissertation Completion Award, numbers (Hoo)
  - o 1 student from College of Agriculture awarded for full year
  - o 7 from a mix of colleges for spring only; 50 % are non-STEM students
- PhD Enhancement Funds, open for proposals by end of week (Hoo)
  - Any department can apply for up to two \$18K award/AY
  - The goal is to help faculty complete more scholarly work
  - UGC reviews and makes recommendations for 8-10 awards;
- Meritorious and Presidential Awards, open (Hoo)
  - Meritorious for new students (\$5K signing bonus, PhD only); typically do not receive enough nominations to use all available funds
  - Presidential (\$1K signing bonus, Masters and Doctoral prospects)
- Update from Faculty Senate (Wilmer)
  - Approved new course in Structural Equations
  - o Plan to revise administrators feedback process
  - Handout: Statement of Tenure crafted by Faculty Senate; not a policy and will be included in handbook once discussed further by Faculty Senate
- DPC update (Brown/Cerretti), handout
  - o Final AW numbers for fall 2016

## **Old Business**

- Application Fees (Hoo, Edwards)
  - o Discussed at Dec 1, 2016 meeting
  - Review of Dec 1 discussion and current procedure
  - Current procedure: students pay the first graduate application fee over their lifetime as a student at MSU—this includes when students change degree-levels within the same program, add certificates, or apply to a new program
  - Peer institutions currently charge fees for new applications for these changes
  - o Graduate School met with University Business Services to discuss proposed fees
  - o New fees would go into the general fund
  - Suggestion: current MSU students after 1 year should pay a fee that is less than application fee
  - Student rep: could receive push-back from students if the changed fee structure affected certificates
  - Dean Hoo asks for Council support to discuss with the Office of The Provost

## New Business

- Department Handbooks (Hoo, Negaard)
  - Encouraging all departments to write and distribute department handbooks to protect all parties
  - FERPA and student records—anything related to student's academic activity is part of student record
  - o There is no standardized graduate student handbook at MSU
  - Important for department to consider if true practices are reflected accurately in department handbook (in need of revision?)
  - Chair Borkowski asks that Council members gather handbooks from their departments and share with Council; he will email Council listserv

  - o To be sent via email
- Level II Proposal, PhD Statistics Education (Hoo, Miles)
