May 6 - Spring Semester ends. Last day to withdraw graduation application.

May 6 - Program of study deadline


- •Master's students must submit the <u>form</u> to The Graduate School by the end of their second semester of attendance.
- •Doctoral students have until the end of their third semester.
- •Certificate students must submit by the end of their first semester.

June 10 - Last day for graduate students to file "Graduation Application"

July 19 - <u>Last day for master's and doctoral comprehensive examination or thesis/dissertation defense if student plans to graduate Summer 2016.</u>

July 19 - Last day for approval of thesis, dissertation, or professional paper (if professional paper is submitted to the library) by <u>formatting advisor</u>.
