

**American Association of University Women (AAUW) Educational Foundation
Fellowships and Grants**

AAUW invites women to submit applications for fellowships and grants in the computer or information sciences, engineering, mathematics or statistics, natural sciences and other fields.

One of the world's largest sources of funding exclusively for graduate women, the AAUW Educational Foundation supports aspiring scholars around the globe, teachers and activists in local communities, women at critical stages of their careers, and those pursuing professions where women are underrepresented.

- * American Fellowships support women doctoral candidates completing dissertations and scholars seeking funds for postdoctoral research leave. One-year postdoctoral research leave fellowships, dissertation fellowships, and summer/short-term research publication grants are offered. (Postmark deadline: November 15, 2007)**
- * Career Development Grants support women who hold a bachelor's degree and who are preparing to advance their careers, change careers, or re-enter the work force. (Postmark deadline: December 15, 2007)**
- * Community Action Grants provide start-up funds for longer-term programs and are restricted to projects focused on K-14 girls' achievement in math, science or technology. (Postmark deadline: January 15, 2008)**
- * International Fellowships are awarded for full-time graduate or postgraduate study or research to women who are not U.S. citizens or permanent residents. Both graduate and postgraduate study at accredited institutions are supported. (Postmark deadline: December 1, 2007)**
- * Selected Professions Fellowships are awarded to women who are U.S. citizens or permanent residents and who intend to pursue a full-time course of study (during the fellowship year) in designated degree programs where women's participation traditionally has been low. (Postmark deadlines: Engineering Dissertation Awards December 15, 2007 and Master's and First Professional Awards January 10, 2008)**
- * University Scholar-in-Residence, located at a college or university, undertakes and disseminates research on gender and equity for women and girls. (Letters of intent are due December 1, 2007; proposals are due February 1, 2008)**
- * Dissertation Fellowships provide support for women doctoral candidates completing dissertations. (Postmark deadline: November 15, 2007)**
- * Summer/Short-Term Research Publication Grants provide support for women college and university faculty and independent researchers to prepare research for publication. (Postmark deadline: November 15, 2007)**
