3. There is no guarantee of renewal of this contract and renewal of contract is solely at the discretion of the University. This post- retirement contract agreement automatically expires at the end of the term of the contract specified above. No further notice relative to non-renewal will be given.
4. This assigned period may be changed annually upon mutual written agreement of the appointee and Montana State University.
5. Annual increases in salary may be made subject to applicable Public Retirement System laws.
6. Appointee shall comply with and abide by all rules and regulations of the Montana University System and the pertinent statues of the State of Montana.
