TRAINING & EQUIPMENT

Morning classroom training on the first day will include Montana Highway Patrol Sergeant Alex Betz presenting on traffic incident management including winter situations as it relates to city street and county road departments. The afternoon session will begin with Motivational Speaker Blu Santee. Senior Risk Consultant, HUB International, on Safety in the Work Place, your part in keeping your work environment safe, especially around equipment. Following will be Equipment Innovations in the field with motor grader field exercise and hands-on equipment walk arounds and demonstrations.
