Workshop Objective: Participants will learn how the Roadway Safety Plus program is operated and updated, and what materials can be printed for safety meetings and will learn safety preventions for backovers and runovers around heavy equipment.

Workshop Description: This course will cover the comprehensive, flexible, multi-threaded Roadway Safety Plus program which contains 33 different topics with interactive and hard copy training materials which can be used as topics for monthly Safety meetings. Preventing backovers and runovers looks at the design and maintenance of an internal traffic control plan to reduce the interaction of heavy equipment and personnel on the ground. The student will review a number of examples of clear zones around heavy equipment and design an internal traffic control plan.

Who Should Attend: Anyone who is involved with safety awareness on the job including disaster response, temporary traffic control, excavation, noise hazards, fall hazards, and operates heavy equipment.

Instructors: Bruce Drewes has worked in transportation for over 30 years, including 12 years as Idaho LTAP Center manager. He is an instructional consultant with the 3T Group. Bruce has a strong background in maintenance and construction when dealing with traffic control, employee and roadway safety, winter operations, and gravel roads.
