

Montana LTAP Presents: 15th Annual Safety Congress • January 24-25, 2017



Workshop Objective: These safety seminars provide a variety of important information ranging from work zones to signing safety for the transportation workforce. By offering work zone safety information, the transportation workforce can select the specific class or classes they need to attend.

Workshop Description:

•**Monday Morning: Work Zone Technician** is a combination of lecture, manuals, video and hands-on problem solving. The five parts of a Traffic Control Work Zone will be discussed. Flagging duties and responsibilities will be taught. Safety, uniformity and liability issues will also be covered in this workshop. Montana Flagger Certificate Cards will be issued to participants successful in completing a test. (2,000 Hours [1 Year] of Temporary Traffic Control Experience Required for WZ Technician Training Certification.)

•**Monday Afternoon & Tuesday: Traffic Control Supervisor** course is 1.5 days and will cover Traffic Control Standards, Fundamental Principles, Traffic Control Devices, and components of the Temporary Traffic Control Zone. A score of 80 percent is needed to pass the exam. Participants must meet the following requirements in order to become TCS certified. The first four items must be received at the Montana LTAP office **before** certifications are issued for TCS and 4,000 Hours (Two Years) of Verified Temporary Traffic Control Experience:

- Current Flagger Card (Montana, Idaho, Oregon, Washington, or ATSSA)
- Successful Completion of Work Zone Technician Course
- Verifiable Field or Design Work Zone Traffic Control Experience - Outline of Your WZ Experience
- Two Reference Letters Verifying WZ Experience
- Successful Completion of TCS Course
- Pass TCS Exam

Who Should Attend: Transportation employees participating in the different courses will learn basic skills of work zone areas, receive flagger certification, receive Traffic Control Supervisor certification, and obtain valuable transportation/worker safety information.

Instructor: Shawna Page is a Montana Certified Flagging Instructor and has been a safety officer and instructor for over fifteen years. She has also worked in the field as a flagger and has taught Work Zone Technician, Traffic Control Supervisor Course, OSHA 10 & 30, Asbestos Safety, Cold Weather Safety, and other safety courses.
