Parking/Transportation Instructions

The rehearsal on Friday evening is at Bobcat stadium. The stadium lot is free starting at 5:00pm that afternoon. Please note that cars may NOT be left in the stadium lot following rehearsal due to the spots being reserved/sold for the football game on Saturday.


The Alumni Band will meet in the "Bison" lot on Saturday morning at 8:30am. Vehicles may remain in that lot for the duration of the day (including the football game). Bus transportation for band members AND their guests is provided from the parking lot to (and from) the Homecoming Parade (downtown). Alumni band members and guest are HIGHLY encouraged to ride the bus to ease with parking/transportation concerns.

Please note that the band will march the Homecoming parade (approximately 1.5 miles). A platform trailer will be available for band members who are unable march that distance.

Following the parade, the buses will return to MSU for a short "touch-up" rehearsal and lunch. The exact location of rehearsal and lunch is not yet determined, but it will be within short walking distance of the MSU Fieldhouse and/or stadium. From this location, we will be "on foot" until after the game. This will include a 0.75 mile tailgating loop from the Fieldhouse around the front of the stadium.

Please note that the band will march the Bobcat "Prowl" and around the front "horseshoe" of the stadium prior to our pregame performance. Members who are not able to walk this distance or pace will be escorted directly to our performance location as they are able.

Water and restrooms will be available following our tailgate loop. Following a short break we will enter the stadium for our Pregame performance. Once we are in the stadium, we will remain inside until the end of the game. Alumni band members are asked to stay with the band until the end of Halftime. Following the game, there will be transportation available from the stadium back to the Bison lot.



Ticketing Information

All performing members of the alumni band will sit with the band in the stadium—game tickets are NOT needed. Other than care-givers who will remain with their band alumni member, family and guests ARE required to purchase a ticket in order to access the game. Tickets may be purchased through the MSU ticket office by using the promo code: MSU125

Please note that MSU has recently implemented a clear-bag policy which prevents anyone from bringing opaque bags into the stadium. Make sure that your family members/guests review the stadium entry protocols to avoid hassle when entering the gates. These increased security procedures do not allow for friends/family members to simply "follow the band" into the gates (as might have been allowed in years past). Only uniformed band members and caregivers will be allowed entry as a group. All other individuals MUST go through the normal spectator gates.

As of now, family and friends of the alumni band members will NOT have access to the field for the performance. Please direct your guests to watch the field shows (both pregame and halftime) from the West/pressbox side of the stadium.

Friday Check-In

Members of the alumni band are asked to check-in prior to rehearsal on Friday afternoon. This will help us determine our food/uniform needs for Saturday. Only performing members need to check-in.

For members of the Alumni Band that are borrowing an MSU-owned instrument, these will be available at check-in on Friday prior to the rehearsal. Please take good care of your instrument and let us know if there are any problems with it following the game.

Music flip folders will be available for purchase (\$5.00) at check-in. We will also have extra copies of the music available.

Uniform/Dress Code

Please adhere to the following dress code for all performing members of the alumni band. Thank you for your cooperation!

Required uniform for 2018 alumni band:

Long Blue Jeans Closed-toe "athletic" shoes Black socks

SotW Alumni Band long-sleeved T-shirt (provided)

SotW ball cap (provided)

Sunglasses may be worn, but should be black, white, blue, or yellow. It is also important that there are no non-uniform colors appearing on other articles of clothing that may show through the uniform. Please wear white or black/navy underlayers if the weather is cold. Be aware of bright colors on shoes, sunglasses, instruments, or coats. Avoid maroon and red (which can look like maroon)!

As of now—and depending on the weather—it is possible that we will fit the entire alumni band in our old marching uniforms. If this is the case, we will have them available at the parking lot starting at 8:00am on Saturday. The final determination will be made at the rehearsal on Friday evening.



What to Expect

Our desire is to make this event fun and positive for all members! With this in mind, there are some things we simply cannot control. All we ask is that you stay positive and remain in communication if you have any needs or concerns throughout the event. We will do our best to accommodate everyone to the extent of our ability.

Band alumni may remember the long action-filled football game-days. This will certainly be one to rival them all! Know your limits, and prioritize your time. We respect and trust you to make the best decisions for you (and your family) during our time together. Here are some special considerations:

- 1. **Poor weather.** There is no chance that this event will be cancelled due to bad weather. If members of the alumni band wish to alter their schedule to accommodate the weather, please keep us informed.
- 2. **Performance quality.** This is going to be a really fun day for everyone. With this in mind, it is still imperative that we maintain a sufficiently high quality of music during all of our performances. Help us create a positive rehearsal/performance atmosphere by listening and responding to instructions and doing your best when playing and with the band. Anyone failing to comply with these goals will be asked to leave the band.
- 3. Lots of standing. We will do our best to give you breaks, snacks, and water, but a typical game-day involves a lot of time on your feet—we are counting on you to know your limits and prioritize your energy and stamina!



- 4. **Alcohol use.** We ask that you refrain from the use of alcohol during alumni band events. Intoxication on the part of any of our students while in playing the band will result in immediate dismissal from the band and loss of scholarship. As such, we expect our alumni to respect this same policy. If an alumni is intoxicated or partaking in alcohol during any of our band events, we will ask to you leave. Thank you.
- 5. **Decorum in the Stands.** Despite what the culture may have been during your years at MSU, our current students are held to a very strict interpretation of the Student Code of Conduct. This includes use of profanity in uniform. Please respect our current students by keeping your comments "clean" and focusing on making the band sound good.
