## **Yellowstone River Rafting: Sunday, Oct. 19**

We will meet at the Outdoor Recreation Center in the S.O.B. Barn (“Save Our Barn”) at 12:00 and return approximately 6:00. Refer to <http://www.montana.edu/campusmap/> (Building #51) for directions. Transportation and group equipment is supplied.

Participants should dress appropriately for anticipated weather conditions.

Please bring the following items:

- > lunch & non-alcoholic beverage (min. space in coolers will be provided for group use)
- > river footwear: which may get wet and can be securely attached (no “flip flops”)
- > rain gear (jacket with hood recommended)
- > hat
- > sunglasses
- > sunscreen
- > change of clothes

Optional:

camera - a disposable, waterproof model is suggested

### Trip Description

The Yellowstone is the longest *free flowing* river in the “Lower 48”. Launch site is Paradise FAS which is located approximately 50 miles from Bozeman. Take-out is Mallard’s Rest FAS. Length of the trip is approximately 7 miles.

- ▶ Generally, there will be 1 coordinator and 6-8 participants/raft.
- ▶ Rafts will be equipped as “paddle boats”
- ▶ Waterproof bags will be provided for stowing essential items while floating (please minimize)
- ▶ Due to space limitations, individual coolers may not be transported in rafts

Please note that this activity is “coordinated” rather than “guided” which essentially means that a greater level of involvement and responsibility is assumed by the participant. Personnel may not possess training, experience or certification commensurate with commercial/professional standards..
