Judging will be held on Friday, April 23rd.

ALL QUILTS are to be picked up between **4:30pm and 5:30pm** on Sunday, April 25th. Please bring your claim ticket. No quilts may be picked up before these times.

NOTICE: We welcome all quilts and quilted articles. Please have all items clean and show ready. The items to be judged will be charged a \$3.00 Entry Fee per quilt or article. The money must be paid at the time of the drop-off. Those entries not paid for at drop-off will be for display only

EXPLANATION OF LEVEL OR SKILL

Beginners-----First quilt entered in a show, entering a category for the first time, or never received a Blue Ribbon.

Intermediate---Has received a Blue Ribbon or higher in the Beginners Class, has entered quilts in shows before and /or has quilted for a moderate time.

Advanced----- has received a Blue Ribbon or higher in the Intermediate Class, does more advanced techniques and have skills that have improved with time.

EXPLANATION OF QUILT SIZES

Quilt - Bed Size Double, Queen or King

Lap or Single 60" x 90" Approx. not to exceed a total circumference of 300"

Baby 45" x 60" Approx. not to exceed a total circumference of 240"

Wall-hangings

Panel A panel must contain significant piece work to be considered a Quilted Entry for judging.

Mini-quilt blocks not over 5" finished, quilt size - 30" x30" not to exceed a total of 120"

Small Not to exceed a total circumference of 144"

Large Not to exceed a total circumference of 240"

Theme The quilt is related to the yearly theme of the quilt show.

Art Quilt Art Quilts are either made totally from a pattern such as McKenna Ryan's "Pine

Needles" art quilt series and / or your interpretation of the pattern or they are original designs where you designed it from scratch or "borrowed" elements from several patterns.
