### **\*Special Notice to BARN DUTY Participants\***

Thank you all for volunteering to take an active part in helping assure the safety of the 4-H animals and barns. Families arriving with campers on Saturday, August 28<sup>th</sup> (Fair readiness day) must **park their campers west of the 4-H horse arena** until **Wednesday, September 1<sup>st</sup> at 10:00 am**. Any time after 10am you may check with Kevin Watson to be informed where to park your camper or tent and he will have an updated Barn Patrol schedule for you. Using this procedure will help Kevin plan for fire lanes in the case of an emergency and can prevent a lot of confusion. **You may receive your camping pass by checking in at the Fair Office. For SAFETY reasons, the two vehicle gates entering the 4-H livestock area will be locked Thursday AM. No vehicles will be able to come in or go out of that area until Sunday at 6:00 p.m. So all campers, etc. requiring vehicles should be in the camping area no later than Wednesday night.** All vehicles parked west of the 4-H horse arena must be moved from that area no later than 9:00am on Sunday. That area will then be used for demolition derby staging activities.



Everyone signed up for Barn Duty is expected to fulfill their responsibility. **Please do not miss working your shift.** When someone doesn't work their shift it may cause another person to take on 4 hours instead of their scheduled 2 hours, or the barns end up not being patrolled which defeats the purpose of safety. Remember, **you are receiving a FREE camping spot due to the 2 hours you have signed up for.**

There must be an adult responsible for anyone under 18 years of age while camping. In respect to all who are camping **"Quite Time"** is from 10pm to 6am every night. Thanks for your cooperation and willingness to help the 4-H program. **Sign-up Deadline - Friday, August 13<sup>th</sup>**
