Orientation, Advising and Registration

Summer Course Registration

To register for summer courses, contact the Academic Advising Center (406) 994-3532 to discuss advising and registration.

Fall Course Registration

If you plan on taking courses in the fall, you **MUST** attend one of the one of the Orientation options below before you can register for your fall classes.

- **Freshmen Students**
 - **To register for fall courses:** New Freshmen are required to attend a formal Orientation program in order to register for fall courses. There are four programs to choose from on **June 13-15, June 27-29, July 11-13, or August 24-26.**
 - To attend Orientation, register for one of these Orientation programs online by going to your Undergraduate Admissions Checklist (for instructions see the enclosed Summer School New Student Checklist). You will receive a confirmation letter with check-in times and locations once you have registered.
- **Transfer Students**
 - **To register for fall courses:** If you intend on taking fall semester courses at MSU, you must attend an Orientation to register for your classes. There are two options for Transfer Student Orientation.
 - **Option 1:** Set up an appointment with an academic advisor in your department (see list below) between Monday, April 18 and Friday, August 19.
 - **Option 2:** If you have not met with your department by August 19, you will need to attend the official Transfer Student Orientation on Wednesday, August 24.
 - Register for either Transfer Student Orientation option by going to your on-line Undergraduate Admissions Checklist (for instructions see the enclosed Summer School New Student Checklist). Prior to your personal advisor meeting stop by the Orientation Office (103 Strand Union) to pick up important registration materials, or, if you are attending the Transfer Student Orientation on August 24, you will be sent an email confirmation after you register.
