### FAFSA Deadline Is Approaching

March 1 is the FAFSA application deadline. If you file your FAFSA by February 25, it is sure to be processed on time.

There is a slight change in the FAFSA next year that you should be aware of. Traditionally, you use the prior year's tax information with which to file. This year, 2016, you will use income data from 2015. Next year, 2017, you will use the same data—2015. This detail may work in your favor if you didn't make much money in 2015. But, in the event that you made more in 2015 than you did in 2016, there is an appeal process that may help out. We will keep you informed and tell you more as it becomes an issue.
