Mr. Barkow will speak to TRIO SSS students on March 1st, from 4-5:30 pm in SUB Ballroom A, followed by a reception.

After graduating from MSU with a degree in Architecture, Mr. Barkow received his Master's degree at Harvard. He practices in Berlin, with his wife and business partner, Regine Leibinger. Barkow and Leibinger's work has been shown at the Venice Architecture Biennale 2008 and 2014, at the Marrakech Beinnale 2012 and is included in the collections of MoMA, New York, among others. They have won National AIA Honor Awards for Architecture, the prestigious Marcus Prize for Architecture and a Global Holcim Innovation Award for sustainability.
