Alcohol Guidelines

1. Social gatherings that include alcohol must be held in the conference room or dining area of the G. W. Prescott Center.
2. Personal use of alcohol is permitted only in the privacy of dormitory rooms, apartments or cabins. All persons consuming alcohol must be of legal age (21). Alcoholic beverages may not be consumed in hallways or other public areas.
3. Client/sponsor or representative assumes responsibility and liability of alcohol consumption. Sponsor's representative must be present during all social functions when alcohol is available. Alcoholic beverages must not be accessible or served to persons under the legal drinking age of 21 or to persons who appear to be intoxicated, regardless of age.
4. The sale of alcohol or any indirect means of collecting money to pay for alcoholic beverages is prohibited unless the event is catered by the licensed vendor contracted by The University of Montana.
5. Alcohol may be provided by the client/sponsor or catering service if no sales are involved. The alcoholic beverages will be stored in the kitchen area of the commissary and a setup fee charged.
6. Service and consumption of alcohol beverages must not exceed four hours.
7. Reasonable amounts of food and non-alcoholic beverages must be served during the duration of the event. Non-alcoholic beverages must be available at the same place and featured as prominently as alcoholic beverages.
