

# MONTANA STATE UNIVERSITY

## UNDERGRADUATE APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Listed below are the types of applicants who should use this undergraduate application form when applying for admission to Montana State University. Applicants must submit application to the Office of Admissions according to the following deadlines: Fall semester - July 1, Spring semester - December 1, Summer session - May 1.

### UNDERGRADUATE APPLICANTS

Undergraduate applicants are those applicants who have **not** earned a baccalaureate degree.

**If the applicant has a high school diploma and has never attended any college or university or has attempted less than 12 college level credits, at a regionally accredited college or university, the following credentials are needed to complete the application file:**

1. Non-refundable \$30.00 application fee payable to MSU-Bozeman
2. Official high school transcript sent after graduation, **directly** from the high school to MSU, posting date of graduation, cumulative grade-point average, and final rank in class
3. Official scores sent **directly** to MSU from ACT or SAT (not required if high school graduation date is more than three years ago)
4. Official transcripts sent **directly** to MSU from each college or university attended, if applicable

**If the applicant has a high school equivalency certificate and has never attended any college or university or has attempted less than 12 college level credits at a regionally accredited college or university, the following credentials are needed to complete the application file:**

1. Non-refundable \$30.00 application fee payable to MSU-Bozeman
2. Official high school equivalency exam scores sent **directly** to MSU from the testing agency
3. Official scores sent **directly** to MSU from ACT or SAT (not required if high school graduation date would have been more than three years ago)
4. Official transcripts sent **directly** to MSU from each college or university attended, if applicable

**If the applicant has attempted 12 or more college level credits at a regionally accredited college or university, the following credentials are needed to complete the application file:**

1. Non-refundable \$30.00 application fee payable to MSU-Bozeman
2. Official transcripts sent **directly** to MSU from each college or university attended

### SECOND DEGREE STATUS APPLICANTS

Second degree status applicants are those applicants who have earned a baccalaureate degree and wish to pursue a second baccalaureate degree. The following credentials are needed to complete the application file:

1. Non-refundable \$30.00 application fee payable to MSU-Bozeman
2. Official transcripts sent **directly** to MSU from each college or university attended. The baccalaureate degree must be posted on the transcript of the institution from which it was received.

### SPECIAL UNIVERSITY ATTENDANCE APPLICANTS

Special University Attendance allows a high-ability student to take a limited number of university credits while still attending high school. Acceptance will be granted to students who demonstrate ability and general maturity. Students will generally only be allowed to take university courses which are not offered in high school. Refer to the current Undergraduate Bulletin.

### EARLY ADMISSION STATUS APPLICANTS

Early admission allows a student of high school age who has not graduated from high school to be considered for regular admission where demonstrated ability and general maturity warrant such acceptance. Admission will be very selective. Refer to the current Undergraduate Bulletin.

## NON-DEGREE UNDERGRADUATE APPLICANTS

Non-degree Undergraduate applicants are applicants who have **not** earned a baccalaureate degree and are wishing to take college courses, but **who are not** interested in pursuing a degree. The following is needed to complete the application file:

1. Non-refundable \$30.00 application fee payable to MSU-Bozeman  
You will be advised by the General Studies Office.  
Students not in good standing at other institutions and former MSU students on suspension are not eligible for non-degree status.  
Non-degree students may not represent the University in intercollegiate athletic competition.  
Non-degree students are not eligible to receive financial aid.
