Scheduling your CLEP at MSU

When scheduling your exam, be prepared to schedule the exact day and hour to reserve your space. A **non-refundable, pre-registration fee of \$15.00 (\$18.00 July 1, 2009)** is payable when you submit an application. The fee is payable in the form of cash, check or money order made payable to MSU Testing Services.

Taking your CLEP Test

The \$70.00 (\$72.00 July 1, 2009) is due at time of testing. The fee is payable in the form of credit card, check or money order made payable to CLEP.

The CLEP is a computerized test. Plan on two hours for the exam. The test times are 8 or 10 am, 1 or 3 pm. Tuesday – Friday year around.
