# WHAT YOU NEED TO COMPLETE

- Update Your Curriculum Sheet with grades of completed courses. Print your curriculum sheet (students in the new revised EDEL curriculum will receive this in a separate email ): <http://www.montana.edu/ehhd/educ/advising/forms.shtml> . Majors in a different department (i.e.: History, Physics, English, etc. will need to pick up their curriculum sheet from appropriate department and meet with main advisor before education. Put a dot by the courses you are currently taking.
- Unofficial Transcripts (My Info/Enter Secure Area/Student Services/Student Records/View grades and transcripts). Confirm grades with transcript for accuracy.
- Education rubrics and numbers are changing for fall! Look at the following page for the course equivalencies.
- Look up classes for next semester (summer, if applicable). Do NOT view through Secure Area but Schedule of Classes instead – just enter My Info/Term/Subject/Course number. Don't worry about days/times or instructors – it is much easier to navigate the system. Use the following form to see how classes fit (Schedule Worksheet) and list courses for next semester on plan ( Semester Plan Sheet):

# Notes

- Are you receiving our emails? If not, you need to set up your student email account found on the lower left hand side of the main MSU website.
- When you check your transcripts, be sure you are classified correctly as an education major. Look at the top of the page.
- EDCI 102 – In- School Experience (now EDU 202) is required for EDSD (secondary) students and EDEL (elementary) who are in the old catalog. It is optional for students in the new revised EDEL curriculum. Check if you are not sure.
- If you have HOLDS on your record, you will not be able to register. Check through your Secure Area – View Holds.
- If you're trying to decide between a couple different courses, review what books are required for the course. # PROGRAM GATES

- Gates for Education Program
  - **Acceptance into the Teacher Education Program** must be completed the **semester before** taking **Methods of Teaching Course and Teacher Practicum**.
    - EDEL due 9/15 or 2/15
    - ESDS due 10/1 or 3/1
  - Be aware of **other gates!!**
    - **Student Teaching Meetings** begin a year prior to student teaching (check link to Field Placement/Licensure)
    - **Graduation Application** must be completed a year prior to graduation.
    - **Praxis II Exam** will be taken the **semester before** Student Teaching.
    - **1<sup>st</sup> Aid/CPR certification** must be completed by the **semester before** Student Teaching.
