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Register System

- Example 1 (top of page 2)
- 7 categories to track:
 - Food, Housing, Transportation, Clothes, Personal Care, Medical, Recreation



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Register System

- Planned spending amounts by category
 - Food=\$300
 - Housing=\$590
- Checking account balance
 - \$300

Rounding

- Round up or down in budget category section
- \$9.06 = \$9.00
- \$9.67 = \$10.00



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
