Outcomes:

Each participant will receive one-on-one vocal instruction as well as classes in theory, ear-training, keyboard, acting, diction, vocal health, professional topics, exercise and more!

Audition Requirements:

Interested singers should submit a recording (CD or YouTube URL) of two contrasting classical songs with piano accompaniment along with application form and registration fee. If accepted into the program, singers will be expected to prepare and memorize the following repertoire before coming to camp:

1. a classical song in English
2. an Italian song from the 17th or 18th century
3. a German lied
4. group repertoire to be determined in May 2012

Singers are strongly encouraged to submit audition materials by **March 31st** to be considered for the program.
