

# **AISES Basketball Tournament Rules and Regulations**

Montana State University American Indian Science and Engineering Society (AISES) is having a Men's and Women's open basketball tournament April 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> 2009.

The Women's Tournament is in honor of the late Miss Indian MSU "Nyree Hogan."  
The prizes will be sponsored by Hogan's family & friends.

The Team coaches are entirely responsible to make sure that their players fully understand tournament rules and regulations, and any bracket changes.

April 5, 2009 is the Deadline for early bird entry fee of \$300. **Anytime after that date a \$50 late fee will be attached.** Cash or Money orders only, No checks please.

1. 10 players max per team. Finalized roster must be approved by the Tournament staff prior to the first game.
2. Absolutely NO team hopping.
3. Teams must have Jerseys of same color and must be numbered 0-99 (No duplicate numbers).
4. A fifteen-minute grace period will be given before a forfeit on Friday night. Ten minutes on Saturday and Sunday.
5. In case of a double forfeit a coin toss will determine the winner.
6. 10 minutes will be given to warm up. With 20 minute halves. Clock will stop last 1 minute in first half and 3 minutes in the second half. Championship games will have 25 minute half's.
7. Players will be given 5 fouls per game.
8. Bonus shots will be given after the 7th team foul, and the team will be in double bonus after the 10th team foul, per half.
9. Each team will be given 2 time outs per half (does not carry over). In case of OT, 1 extra time out will be given. 3 minutes will be given for over time (clock will stop on any dead ball).
10. 30 point rule is in effect for last 5 minutes of the game.
11. Technical fouls will be given to any player/team for behavior established in signed agreement. It will count as a personal foul. Player/ manger/ coach will pay \$20.00 to AISES for the first technical in order for the player to be allowed back into the game. In case of a second technical foul, a \$40 fine will be assessed and the player will be disqualified from the game. The player must pay before they can re-enter the tournament.

12. Technical fouls will accumulate through the tournament, if a player receives 3 technical fouls they will be disqualified from the tournament.
13. If an individual/team receives a technical foul, the individual/team will be disqualified from receiving an MVP, Mr./Mrs. Hustle, 3-Point Champion
14. Attendance at the Coach's meeting is MANDATORY prior to competing.
15. Any intimidating manner or verbal or physical threat will not be tolerated by the committee members, referees, and fans. Authorities will be contacted and you will be escorted off the premises.

- We as a team have read and agree to abide by the Rules & Regulations that govern your basketball tournament.
- We fully understand and agree that the Montana State University, AISES and its members and volunteers will not tolerate any verbal abusive language and or physical threats.
- We also understand that the Montana State University and AISES are NOT responsible for any injuries or accidents incurred during the tournament, or for lost and damaged items.
