GENERAL GUIDELINES: This award is given on the basis of scholastic achievement, involvement with psychology, and future psychology goals.

CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY: To be considered for this award a student must:

1. Be a psychology major at MSU.
2. Be of junior or senior standing.
3. Have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
4. Show special interest in Psychology: for example, experience as a research assistant, completion and/or proposal for a Psychology research project and/or distinctive field experience.
5. Demonstrate future interest in the field of psychology

Please note: you do NOT have to be a member of Psi Chi to apply!

PROCEDURES: Students must submit the application, a print-out of an unofficial transcript, a curriculum vita outlining experience in psychology, and a 200 word (or less) future psychology goals statement. Applicants are welcome to submit a supplemental writing sample and/or a research statement.

RECOGNITION

The award-recipient will be notified in mid-December. The recipient will be formally announced in the campus wide "Day of Student Recognition" in the spring semester. Recipients will receive a certificate and their name will be inscribed on a plaque for display in the department.
