Applying:

- Meet with a member of the D.I.S. Oversight Board, D.I.S. Director, Honors Advisor, current D.I.S. student, or Dr. Lee to ask questions, clarify any misconceptions, and decide if the D.I.S. is the right choice for you.
- Create, design, or brainstorm ideas for one or more killer ideas for an interdisciplinary project.
- Decide on the three disciplines needed to accomplish your project.
- □ Find mentors within your areas of interest
 - o Request letters of recommendation (two required)
 - Find three faculty advisors, one for each discipline
- Meet with your faculty advisors jointly, so they can review and help you refine your project and course plan. (Honors can help schedule and find available class room)
- □ Finalize all parts of the application:
 - o Application
 - o Project Proposal
 - o Faculty Advisor Committee
 - o Course Plan
 - Funding (not required, but helpful)

After Acceptance:
