Following the workshop, volunteers are welcomed to stay and assist with pruning the Heritage Orchard. The Crow Creek Orchard, owned by Chad & Claudia Lunt, was established in the early 1900's. It was planted by Eli Toma, who homesteaded on the property 80-90 years ago. Eli Toma walked out on Eastern Europe during WWI, and came to America as a stowaway. He found his way to Montana where he homesteaded the property.
