The Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program provides free tax help to people with household income under \$54,000.

Volunteers assist people with basic federal and state income tax returns. Free electronic filing will be available for most 1040 Forms.

## TAXPAYERS MUST BRING:

- 2019 W-2 forms
- Forms 1099
- Forms 1095-A, B, or C  
(Affordable Care Statements)
- all other tax documents
- picture ID
- social security cards for each person listed on return
- copies of 2018 tax returns (if available)

International students and employees should also bring their passports and visas.
