THE SARS-COV-2 VIRUS HAS NOT BEEN FOUND

It is unlikely that you are infected with SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19.

WERE YOU IN CLOSE CONTACT

with someone who tested positive for COVID-19?



Not that I know of



STAY SAFE

Keep social distancing and maskwearing when around others.



If your exposure was recent, the test might have failed to detect the virus that is in your body. Self-isolate as much as possible for 14 days after your last contact with that person. Continue to monitor for any symptoms (ex: fever, cough, shortness of breath) and wear a mask to protect others in your household.
