The Custer Gallatin National Forest is looking for candidates interested in an On Scene Coordinator (OSC) position for the Riley Pass Uranium Mines CERCLA Response Action. The position will be located at the Custer Gallatin National Forest Supervisor's Office, Bozeman, Montana.

The On Scene Coordinator position supports the principal OSC on the Riley Pass Project, a multi-year abandoned mine reclamation effort located in Harding County, South Dakota. Typical duties for this position include project planning and design, budget management, contract preparation and administration, and construction oversight. Experience with land reclamation techniques, earthworks construction, and construction project management are highly desirable but not a prerequisite.

The position will be advertised as interdisciplinary, including federal job series environmental engineer (0819), and physical scientist (1301).
