

## Lab Notebook Grade Criteria

### Evaluation Key:

- ☐ 1. The notebook provides complete and accurate description of laboratory activities, with drawings and sketches of circuits (experiments) including connections to test equipment, and textual description of measurement procedures.
- ☐ 2. Data is recorded in clear tabular format, with explanations linking measurement data to the description of the measurement being performed.
- ☐ 3. Prelab and companion calculations are included in the notebook and initialed to certify they were completed on time.
- ☐ 4. Where appropriate, data is compared to theoretical predictions. Data and theory are presented graphically where sensible.
- ☐ 5. Notebook is legible, and neatly organized, with graphical data, listings, etc. pasted or taped in place, and tables and graphs clearly labeled, especially including graph axes. Notebook should include a table of contents on the first pages or inside the front cover.
