## Please note:

- Minimum commitment time is 2 or 3 weeks depending on the camp.

  Students may stay for a single or multiple camps, and up to the duration of the summer season (~8 weeks).
- Fieldwork occurs in the rugged Montana backcountry and consists of strenuous physical activity for extended periods of time conducted outdoors during hot summer months under changing and unpredictable weather conditions.
- All camp meals are provided by MOR Paleo during the work week. Meals on town day are the students' responsibility.
