Ecology Internship



The Natural Resources Group monitors vegetation on the Idaho National Laboratory (INL) Site to assess Greater sage-grouse habitat and update Long-term Vegetation Survey, one of the oldest maintained sagebrush steppe vegetation datasets. Multiple ecological internship positions are available for the 2022 summer field season for full-time students seeking to gain or develop field experience.

- Conduct vegetation surveys
- Collect and manage field data
- Plant Identification
- Record GPS data
- Operate 4WD vehicles
- Access remote off-trail plots

Paid positions are temporary, full-time between 13 to 14 weeks in length. The start date is May 16, 2022. Interns will report to our Idaho Falls office between 4:30 – 6:30 am., Monday – Thursday for ten-hour shifts. Field work will be conducted on the INL Site which covers nearly 900 square miles of sagebrush steppe on the Snake River Plain 45 miles west of Idaho Falls, ID.
