This project is part of a long-term study of avian community response to pinyon-juniper thinning practices with a mark-recapture survival and site fidelity component focused on select species. This student will be advised by Dr. Clint Boal. Field work is conducted May – early August of 2023 and 2024 and takes place in central New Mexico. This position is funded for 2.5 years by the US Bureau of Land Management.

Qualifications: Applicants must have a BS (at time of hire) in wildlife ecology, natural resources management, biology, or a closely related field, with a minimum GPA of 3.0 and be professional and highly motivated for graduate research. Coursework in ornithology, experience conducting point-count bird surveys, and experience mist-netting and banding passerines is required. Strong skills in ArcGIS/QGIS are highly desired.
