Overview of Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Travel to and sample rangeland sites throughout the state of Wyoming
- Navigate to rangeland sites using a GPS and a 4-wheel vehicle to collect accurate field data
- Read and record line point intercept transects
- Collect vegetative forage production data by clipping

- Skilled in operating UTVs
- Willingness to travel and camp overnight across Wyoming
- Ability to lift over 30lbs
- Ability to hike difficult terrain in variable weather conditions
