Purpose and Scope of Position

The Seasonal Information & Intelligence (I&I) Technician is an entry-level support position within the I&I section of the Field Services Administration department of the Field Services Division at Wildfire Defense Systems. This position proactively identifies, monitors, and reports wildfires and the actions performed by WDS firefighting response teams. The Seasonal I&I Technician also regularly serves as a liaison to internal and external clients, providing pertinent information to stakeholders.

Organizational Relationship

This position reports to the I&I Shift lead and is within the I&I Section of Field Services Administration Department of Field Services Division.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Locate and monitor wildfires across the US utilizing a variety of online resources
- Create and maintain daily logs of fire activity
- Create, update, and manipulate wildfire perimeters using geospatial tools such as Google Earth, social media, and satellite imagery
- Carefully craft client-facing and internal reports and analyses
- Continuously document field operations and actions taken on a property including managing property photos, engine movement, and property information
- Participate in continuous improvement projects to improve efficiency in departmental function
- Other duties as assigned
