River Recreation Study Goals

1. **Conduct Intercept Surveys of River Users** to provide insight into how people recreate on the river and their overall 'on-the-river' experience
2. **Measure overall Use of River Access Sites** with boat launch facilities.
3. **Establish Baseline of Recreational Use** on the Upper Yellowstone River by level and type of use, time of season and location
4. **Work with River Interests** to identify issues and impacts, and collaboratively work to develop potential solutions.

- Conducting observational surveys of vehicles present at fishing access sites along the Yellowstone River
- Collecting data on current conditions at fishing access sites
- Noting of any other additional observations relevant to recreation on the Yellowstone River
