- 2) Be enrolled in and **complete** <u>at least **two** projects</u> each year of high school.
- 3) Exhibit leadership skills in 4-H related activities.
- 4) Be a high school graduating senior of the current year.
- 5) Enrolled, or planning to enroll, in an accredited school of post-secondary education.
- 6) Submit up to date 4-H Record book with an application.
- 7) 4-H Record book must be completed before funds will be released.
